The Inland Empire Economic Partnership (IEEP) Board of Directors is pleased to announce the eleventh year of the Regional Leadership Academy. The Regional Leadership Academy program will provide its participants the invaluable experience of becoming a steward to our region. By expanding their understanding of the people, places, and trends shaping our region, the participants will become more valuable employees and citizens of the Inland Region.
