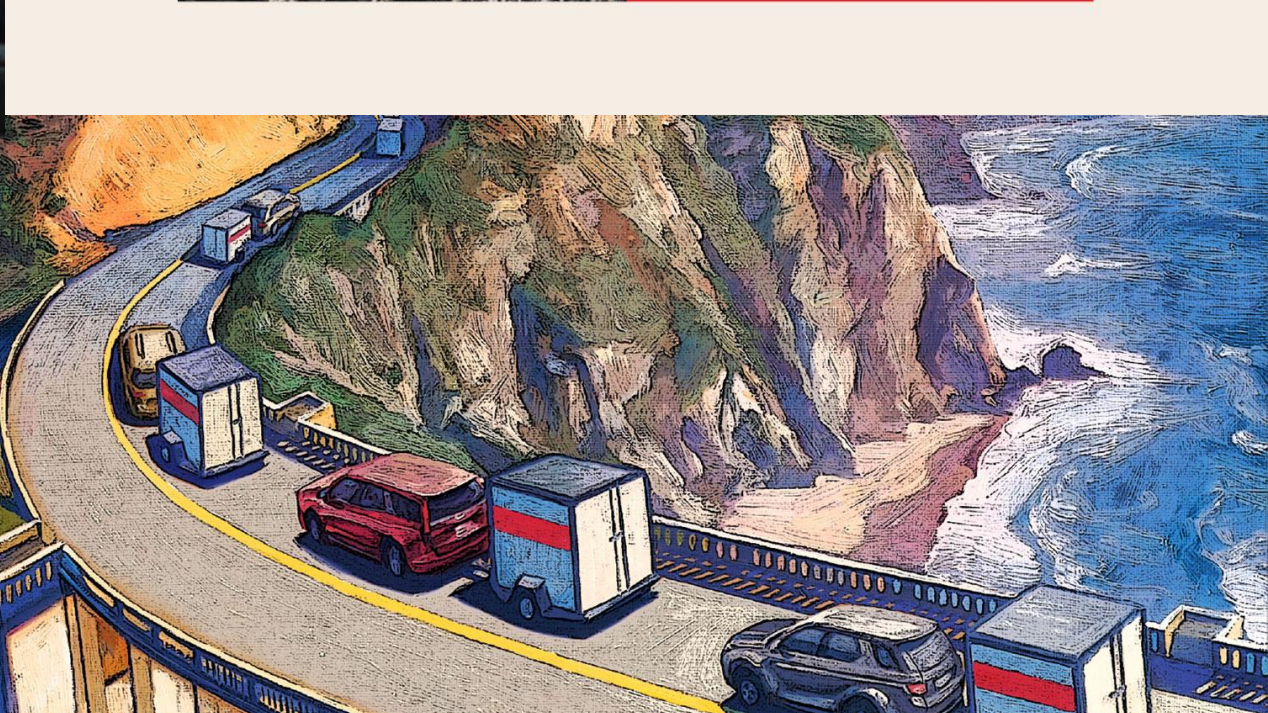


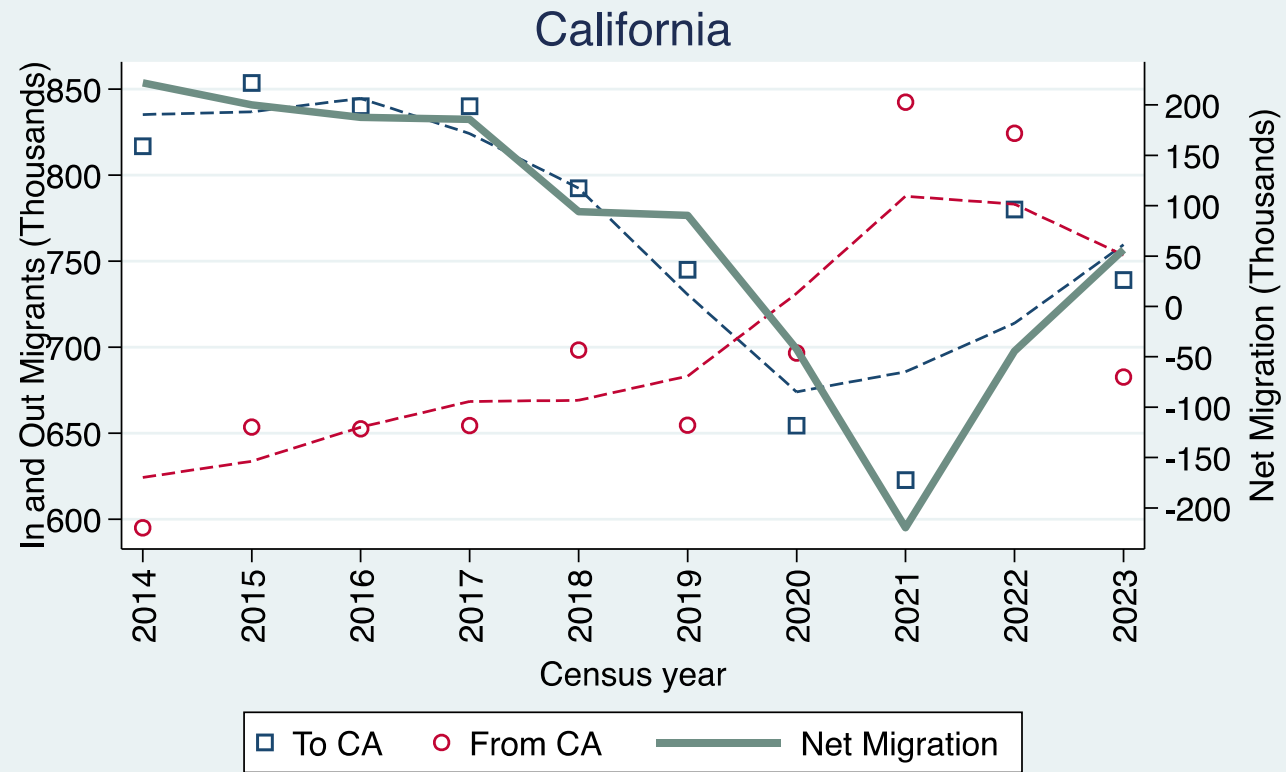

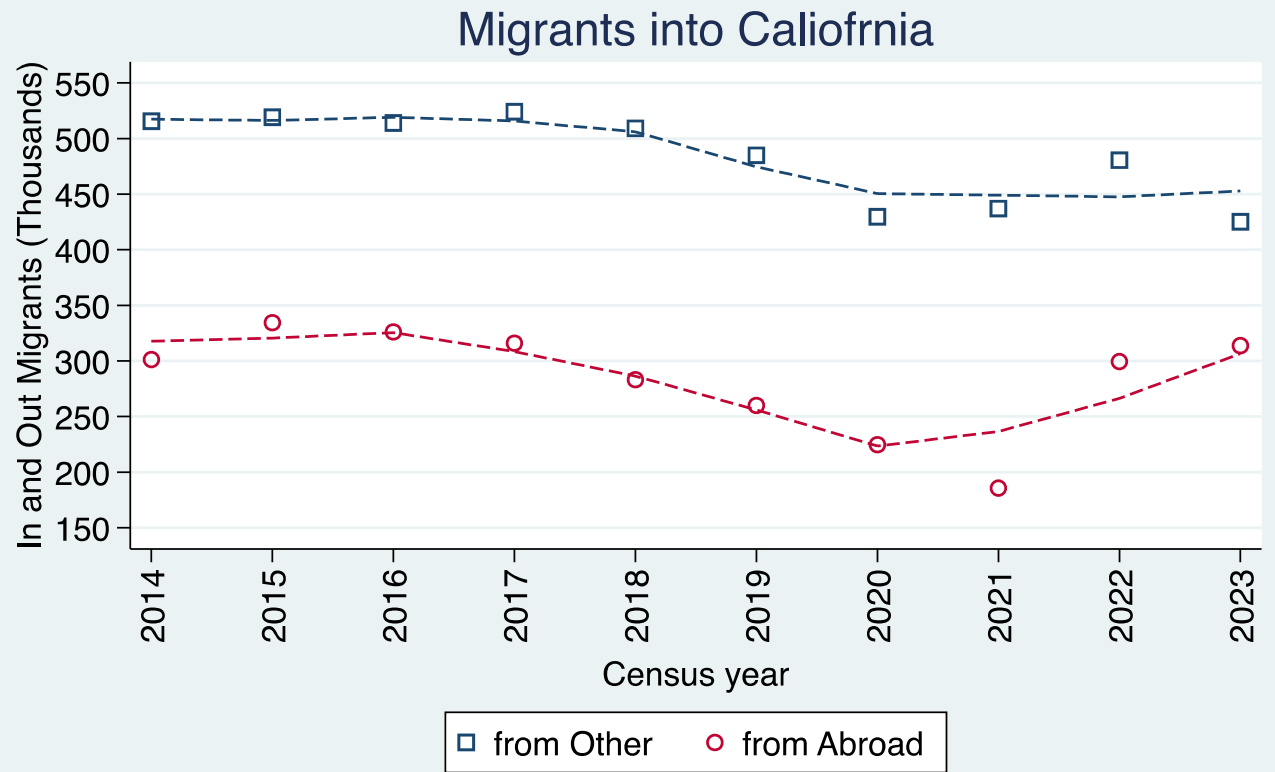


Immigrants to and from California

Source of Immigrants into CA



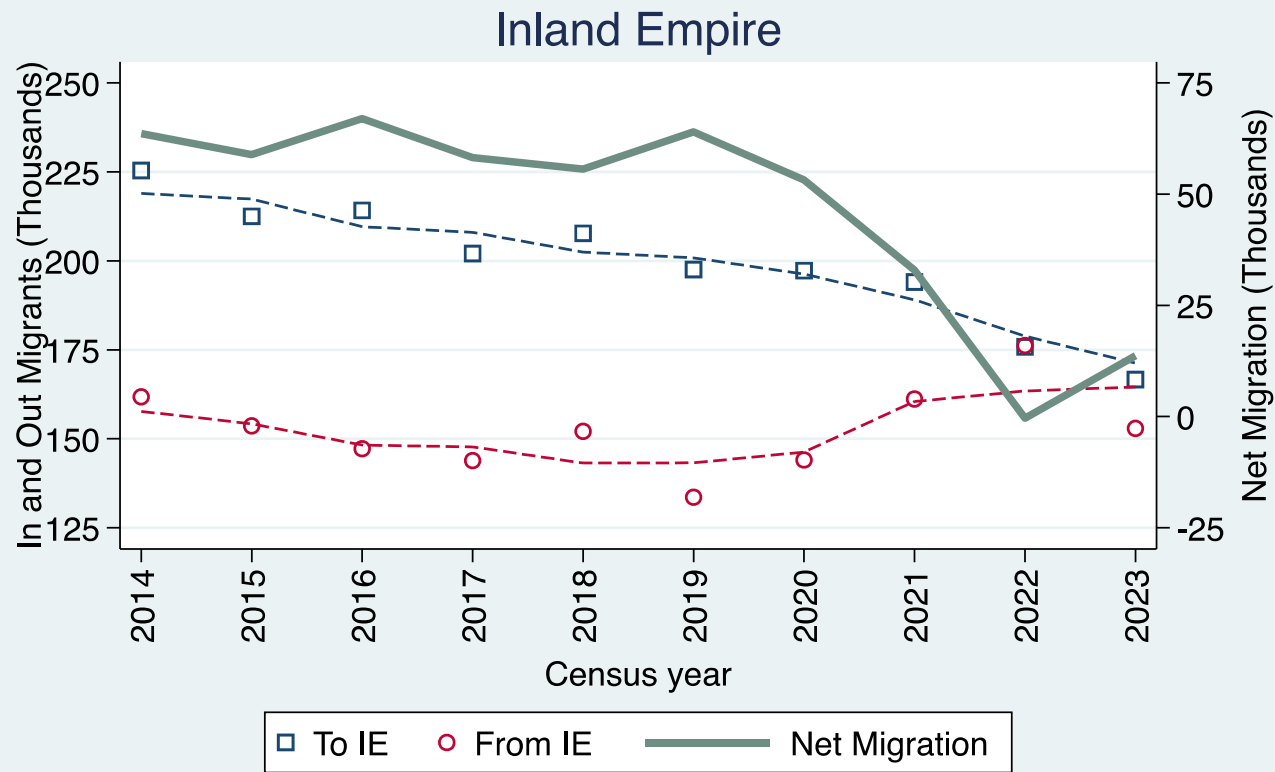

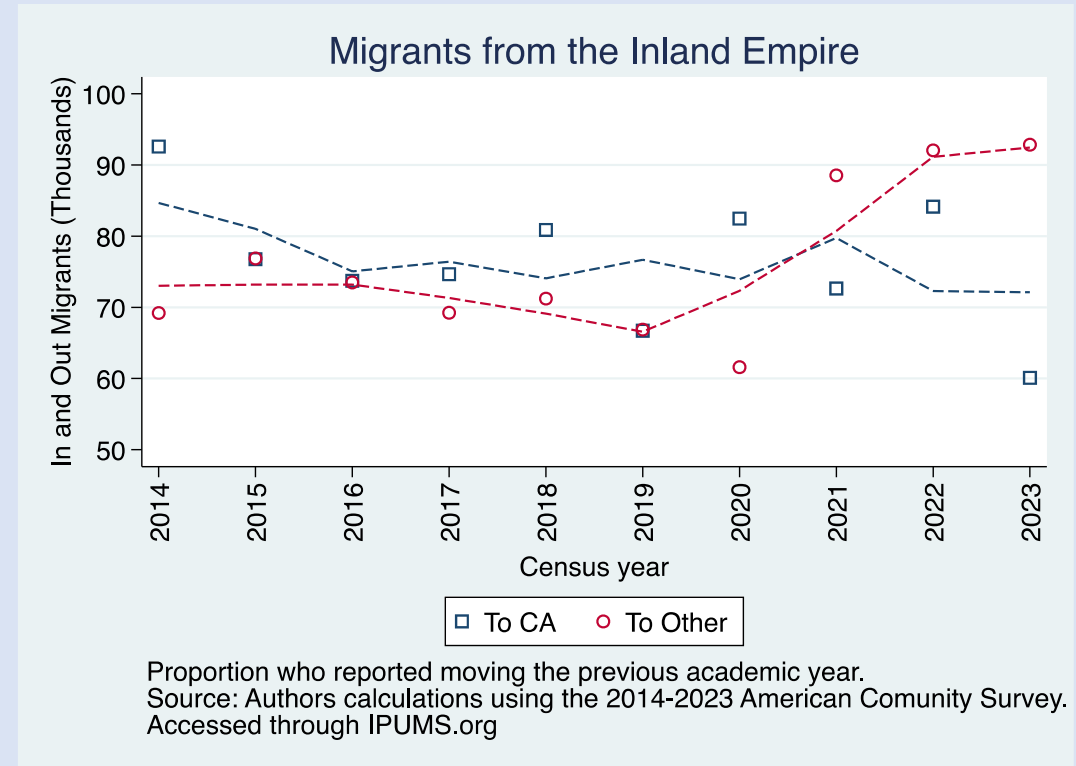
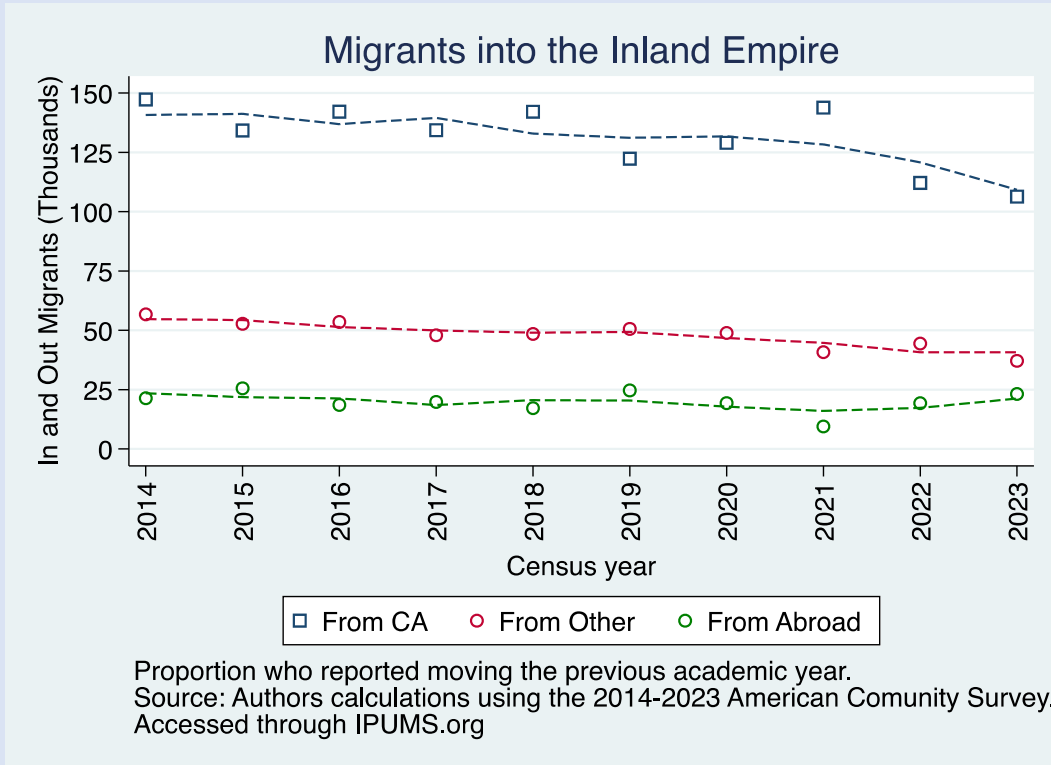

Summary

- Net migration to California has rebounded
 - Mostly due to immigrants from abroad
- Yet net migration to the IE has decreased
 - Due to less people moving from other CA cities
 - Due to more people leaving to other states
- Affordability, preferences for public goods, and amenities drive out migration
- Policy can be effective at decreasing flows of workers

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
